Need to apply?

You can apply for the Oregon Health Plan (OHP) or Healthy Kids at any time of the year. There is no “Open enrollment” period for OHP. Private plans have an open enrollment period. Visit OregonHealthCare.gov to learn more.

Questions about renewing OHP coverage?

Every year, Oregon Health Plan (OHP) and Healthy Kids members must update their information. This helps OHP know if you still qualify for health benefits. Not everyone will renew at the same time. When it is your turn to renew your benefits, OHP will send you a letter with instructions. If you did not receive a letter, then you do not have to renew your benefits at this time.
